

Example of 1st Term Payment Calculations

First term payments are 65% of all fees due September 15th
Remaining account balances are due in full January 15th

Examples of students calculating their 1st term payment amount:

Jacob is from NS, in the business program, living on campus traditional residence in a double room

Tuition and ancillary fees	\$9,369.66
Double room	\$5,845.00
Block 415 (Includes 300 DCB*) Jacob's meal plan selection	\$6,075.00
Jacob's total fees used to calculate his 1st term payment	\$21,289.66
Jacob's 1st term payment is 65% of the total \$21,289.66 X 0.65	\$13,838.28

Chloe is from PEI, and is the Nursing program, living in Riley Hall in a single room

Tuition and ancillary fees	\$11,304.06
O'Regan Hall & Riley Hall - Single	\$8,805.00
Block 315 (Includes \$300 DCB*) Chloe's meal plan selection	\$5,355.00
Chloe's total fees used to calculate his 1st term payment	\$25,464.06
Chloe's 1st term payment is 65% of the total \$25,464.06 X 0.65	\$16,551.64

Emma from Nova Scotia is in the Business program living off campus

Tuition and ancillary fees	\$9,630.36
Emma's 1st term payment is 65% of the total \$9,630.36 X 0.65	\$6,259.74

Zhang Wei from China in his second year of science, living in a private room in Governors Hall

Tuition and ancillary fees (includes International fee)	\$21,038.02
Governors Hall - Private (Includes \$800 DCB*)	\$9,605.00
Zhang Wei did not purchase a meal plan	\$0.00
Zhang Wei's total fees used to calculate his 1st term payment	\$30,643.02
Zhang Wei's 1st term payment is 65% of the total \$30,643.02 X 0.65	\$19,917.97

Scholarship - students who receive a StFX scholarship use 50% as part of the 1st term payment
NS Bursary - Student who receive the NS Bursary use 50% (\$641.50) as part of 1st term payment

Late Payment Fee:

First Term - \$50 - if payment delayed beyond September 15

Second Term - \$50 - if payment delayed beyond January 15

Interest charged at the rate of 1% per month (12% per annum) on overdue balances on the last day of each month.
