The **Department of Sociology** invites applications for **two** limited-term (9-month) appointments at the level of Assistant Professor to begin August 15, 2023. Applicants must have a PhD or nearly-completed PhD in Sociology or related fields and provide evidence of strong teaching and research.

We seek candidates with the ability to teach Introductory Sociology and Social Theory and some of the following courses: Social Movements, Social Dissent, Sociology of Religion, Sociology of Environment, Disability, and / or Social Justice.

StFX is a top-ranked, primarily undergraduate university that continually seeks to evolve its curriculum, programs, and degrees to reflect new knowledge.
