

# WASTE COLLECTION

There are waste streaming sites available on campus with the following signage:



## 1. WHERE DO I TAKE MY WASTE FOR SORTING?

In dorm style residences, waste is collected 7 days a week from sorting stations and from bathrooms.

In MacIsaac and Lane Hall residences there are sorting stations setup on each floor for students to sort their waste accordingly. The cleaners will remove it daily.

In all other residences students are expected to bring their waste to their Recycling Room and sort the streams according.

In Powers & Somers Hall residences, students are responsible to take their sorted waste to the bins located in the parking lot on the North side of the building near Memorial Field.

In West Street Apartments, students are responsible to take their sorted waste to the bins located in the parking lot in front of the building.

- Paper: Newspaper, loose leaf, boxes, paper towel rolls, envelopes, food boxes
- Plastics/Glass/Refundables: Juice/pop bottles, beer bottles, cans, wine bottles, yogurt containers, plastic bags, wrappers
- Garbage: Coffee cups, pens, Styrofoam containers, bottle lids
- Compost: Food scraps, napkins, Kleenex, pizza boxes

## 2. ARE BAGS PROVIDED?

Appropriate bags are available for students and can be found in the laundry rooms.
