New Task Force Recommendation regarding Academic Integrity

The Task Force recently passed a recommendation designed to provide students more information about academic integrity. Under this recommendation, the Student Success Center, in consultation with the Teaching and Learning Centre, will create a Moodle exercise about academic integrity. The Moodle resource will appear on all student Moodle home pages, alongside the student's other courses. More detailed information about the content of the exercise, and how students and instructors can use it, will be sent when the program is ready to launch. StFX Student Laptop Technology Bursary

Recognizing that not all students have access to adequate technology for taking online courses, the Online Task Force earlier passed a recommendation that the university provide needs-based grants to help students access laptops. This initiative has become particularly important as StFX has moved to a 'Bring Your Own Device' model for 2019-20. The StFX Laptop Technology Bursary

was launched on August 7 and is receiving applications until August 16. The program invites students whose financial situation prevents them from obtaining their own device to apply to be considered for a \$500 bursary.
