In the spirit of picking up the calls to action of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission StFX is committing itself to both decolonizing and Indigenizing the campus community. On November 7 & 8 Chief Justice and Senator Murray Sinclair will be honoring us with a visit to our campus.

As the Chair of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission (TRC), Murray Sinclair provided excellent leadership in this important, often difficult and painful process. For those of you who have not heard Chief Justice Sinclair speak please look up some of his podcasts and interviews on CBC. His insights and observations are transformational. He speaks the difficult truths that came out of the testimonies of the many residential school survivors who were able to be witnesses at the TRC. But he is also able to talk about the hopefulness that can come from moving forward in a new relationship between Settler and Aboriginal peoples in this country. Please watch your email for the link to the presentation Chief Justice Murray Sinclair will be making in November. It will be livestreamed and well worth watching. As such we all, whichever side of the treaties we find ourselves, will take away learnings from his presentation.

StFX also welcomed Charlene Bearhead to campus in late summer to lead a forum on Treaty Education in the province. This initiative is being led by Jaime Battiste and co-chaired by partners at StFX (Dr. Jeff Orr), the Province (Ian Doucette and Janet Porter) and Mi'kmaw Kina matnewey (Eleanor Bernard) and is designing professional learning in treaty education for public school students, government workers and the general public. This forum reminded us of the power in partnerships and that if we all, from wherever we are situated, commit to unlearning, learning and relearned a more inclusive understand of our nation to nation relationships we will move forward in ways that create more balance and hence more justice.

Enjoy the fall! Just a reminder which will keep Jennifer happy (and we all want to keep Jennifer happy!!) to sign up asap for winter and spring courses so that we are not in a position where we have to cancel them...

Want to be on the same page as everyone else? Install Office 365!

- ✓ Microsoft Office 365 can be installed on up to 5 devices for free by all StFX faculty, staff, and students. Office 365 contains Word 2016, PowerPoint 2016, Excel 2016, and other useful applications. It can be installed on both Windows and Mac.
- ✓ If you install Office 365, you will be able to work collaboratively with your peers and submit assignments to your instructor without running into file or platform compatibility issues.
