- Summer School 2012 will be held **July 9 - August 3**. The Summer School schedule will be emailed to students once it becomes available.
- Students intending to graduate at the upcoming **Spring 2012 Convocation** are reminded that they must apply to do so. The application can be found in the self serve module of your personalized MesAMIS.
- Students intending to graduate at the **Fall 2012 Convocation** must ensure that they have met all program requirements by the conclusion of the summer 2012 term. **Please note: Students enrolled in Fall term courses are not eligible to graduate at the Fall convocation.**
