

WHY EAP?

This is more than an ESL or Test Prep course. EAP@X will help you

- improve your English reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills;
- develop academic competencies such as research and referencing; and
- provide a pathway to your full-time studies at StFX (successful completion of Level 6 guarantees entry to your chosen StFX academic program the following semester).

You will gain insight into the teaching and learning styles of the Canadian classroom in the small, friendly environment of the StFX campus located in Antigonish, Nova Scotia, Canada.



Level 5: In the intermediate level, students critically evaluate readings and write academic essays. They develop skills in listening and speaking through lectures, presentations, debates, and discussions.

Level 6: In the advanced level, students further develop critical reading and writing, listen to and take notes on lectures, give presentations, lead class discussions, and carry out an academic research project.



- Programs begin in September, January, and June
- Each level runs for 12 weeks (300 hrs)
- Classes delivered Monday Friday, 8:30 am-2:30 pm
- The two academic levels require the following test scores for entry:

SPEAKING & LISTENING

- increase fluency and accuracy in oral and written English
- increase comfort with giving presentations and participating in discussions
- develop note-taking skills for university lectures build communication skills

READING & WRITING

- develop critical reading & writing skills at a university level
- establish ability to meet academic standards in summarizing, paraphrasing, and quoting
- develop a clear understanding of academic integrity rules and penalties
- improve competency in academic researching and referencing

GENERAL SKILLS

- foster independent learning and enhance collaborative skills
- provide strategies for problem solving and handling stress in a university setting
- encourage cultural awareness and contribution
- improve time management skills & study skills
